- will review the letters they already learned.
- learn the vowels that produce the "o" and "oo" sounds. Cholam and Shuruk.

Jewish Studies:

We learned about the Parashah: the weekly portion read from the Torah.

We worked on the first Parashah called Beresheet (Genesis) which describes the creation of the world, and continued with: Noah (The story of Noah and the Ark), Lekh Lekha (The story of Abraham), Chayei Sarah, Toldot, and all the related parashot until Parashat Vayechi.

Also we are learning what a Siddur is (the prayer book) and began creating our own Siddur.

The first Tefillot (prayers) we will learn about are Modeh Ani, Ma Tovu, Shema and Sim Shalom.

Holidays:

Hanukkah – The students will learn the story of Hanukkah, why and how we celebrate this holiday.

We will emphasize the two miracles which are the reason for this celebration.

In addition they will experience lighting the Hanukkiyah, reciting the blessings, singing related songs, playing with Dreidels, and eating latkes.
